1. Stephen Curry, Golden State Warriors

At 34, Stephen Curry is the **best NBA players right now**. There's little question about that after he drove Golden State to its fourth title in eight years, winning NBA Finals MVP without precedent for the process.

In the Finals against Boston, Curry arrived at the midpoint of 31.2 points, 6.0 bounce back and 5.0 assists while shooting 44% from distance. Forget about today. This buddy is an unequaled great.

2. Giannis Antetokounmpo, Milwaukee Bucks

How great has the Greek Oddity been in recent seasons? The two-time NBA MVP is averaging 28.4 points, 11.7 bounce back, and 5.6 assists since the start of the 2017-18 campaign.

He won the NBA Finals MVP in 2021 as well as continues to become better at the still-young age of 27. He will be amongst the best NBA players enduring.

3. Nikola Jokic, Denver Nuggets

Still just 27, he's averaging 26.7 points, 12.3 bounce back and 8.1 assists while shooting 58% from the field over the past two seasons. Not terrible for a fat youngster from Serbia.

4. Luka Doncic, Dallas Mavericks

Watching Doncic carry Dallas to the Western Conference Finals this past season got us thinking.

Have we seen a 22-year-old player requested to accomplish such a great deal since LeBron James was somehow making Cleveland relevant ages prior?

El Niño Maravilla arrived at the midpoint with 31.7 points, 9.8 bounce back, and 6.4 assists in the playoffs.

Dallas' second-driving scorer was Rick Brunson's child. No doubt.

5. Kevin Durant, Brooklyn Nets

Despite the Nets additionally having stars such as Kyrie Irving and Ben Simmons, Kevin Durant's **best NBA players right now** demonstrates he is among the best of the best every time he steps out on the court.

Tragically, his 2021-22 customary season was characterized by wounds.

One really should stop and think about whether Durant's kid body is nearly separating.

At the exceptionally least, he's now set to return to Brooklyn after backing off a past trade request.

6. Joel Embiid, Philadelphia 76ers

The often-harmed Joel Embiid is now among the best NBA players in the game right now. We're talking about the most-dominant enormous man since Dwight Howard was thriving.

This past season showed us this amazingly with him completing as an MVP finalist after averaging 30.6 points and 11.7 bounce back. Just flat crazy numbers.

7. Jayson Tatum, Boston Celtics

Tatum's struggles in the NBA Finals will add to some recency predisposition. With that said, he drove Boston to its first Finals since 2010 and did as such while acting the part of a true superstar.

That included averaging 25.6 points, 6.7 rebounds, and 6.2 assists throughout the Celtics' playoff run. At just 24, Tatum will just continue to get better and one of the **best NBA players right now**.

8. LeBron James, Los Angeles Lakers

LeBron James has been accused of being selfish because he has tracked down the fountain of youth but won't let his friends know where it is.

He is now 37 years of age and continues to show he has many, numerous years left in his career.

Showing no indications of dialing back any time soon, LBJ found the middle value of 30.3 points, 8.2 rebounds, and 6.2 assists in 2021-22. That's just insanity.

9. Devin Booker, Phoenix Suns

Stardom. That's what we saw from the 25-year-old Devin Booker during Phoenix's shocking rush to the NBA Finals in 2021-22.

Booker built on that this past standard season, averaging 26.8 points on 38% shooting from three-point range.

10. Ja Morant, Memphis Grizzlies

After driving the Memphis Grizzlies to their first postseason since 2017, the **best NBA players right now** Ja Morant took his team to a whole new level in 2021-22.

On the way to driving Memphis to the second-best record in the NBA, the previous Rookie of the Year arrived at the midpoint of 27.4 points, 5.7 rebounds, and 6.7 assists on 49% shooting.

At 22, Morant is quite possibly of the best young player in the game.
